

Recyclables List

With the exception of the recyclables listed below, all trash must be in "tied" 12 to 32 gallon trash bags weighing no more than 40 pounds each. Bags must be capable of supporting weight placed in them without ripping when handled. Using cardboard boxes for trash in place of trash bags is not allowed, as all boxes must be recycled (per Steuben County requirement).

Larger items, such as vacuum cleaners, artificial Christmas trees, etc... do not need to be bagged.

Plastic	Glass	Paper	Cans & Metal
<p>All milk jugs & coffee containers. All number 1 & 2 plastic containers with a threaded/screw on cap (these will usually be a bottle, jug or jar only).</p> <p>Not accepted: Other than those mentioned above, items with a "snapable lid" must be discarded as trash (regardless of number), as they are considered wide mouth food containers and are not accepted by the County.</p> <p>No medicine bottles. No other items are accepted.</p>	<p>Cleaned Clear & colored glass bottles.</p> <p>Not accepted: Pyrex, window glass, ceramics, light bulbs or auto glass</p>	<p>Newspaper, magazines, glossies, catalogues, telephone books, junk mail, white and colored paper and envelopes (shredded paper must be bagged).</p> <p>Not accepted: Paper with other materials attached (such as spiral bindings, bubblewrap or cardboard), plastic bags, foil wrappers or tissue paper.</p>	<p>Cleaned tin & aluminum cans, small metal items such as pots & pans, old faucets, etc..., small & large appliances (please call or email us and advise us, when setting out appliances - fees apply).</p> <p>Not accepted: Aerosol, paint or fuel cans.</p>

These top four materials may combined into one tote or a smaller type trash can and placed out for weekly pickup. We sort them for you. Please do not store and put out large amounts of recycling at one time. We also pick up the material listed below on a weekly basis.

Cardboard & Pasteboard (corrugated) (food boxes usually)
<p>Broken down (not stomped), flattened and stacked cardboard and pasteboard. We highly recommend either tying this material or placing your recycling tote or trash can on top of this material to prevent it from being blown away. This will also help keep it dry in the event of light precipitation. Limit: 6 inch stack</p> <p>Not accepted: Cardboard with waxy surface (such as milk & orange juice cartons)</p>

Electronics
<p>Please place your electronic device on the ground next to your regular recycling. These items must never be bagged or mixed with regular trash. We accept one electronic device, upto 5 lbs per week, per residence, free. Freon items are not considered electronic devices. Call (607) 962-5865 for these items. No TV's or monitors (of any type). Customers may take these to the Erwin Transfer Station for recycling (there is a \$15 County fee for recycling them).</p> <p>Devices over 5 pounds are charged a premium fee of 10¢ /pound. However, Steuben county residents may also take any of these electronic devices to the Erwin Transfer Station or Bath Landfill for recycling.</p>
